Hotline Meals Service is here once again with a project to help young people and their family going through a crisis. Working in partnership with the BBC Children in Need, we are looking to support those in need.

Our aim is to improve the lives of disadvantaged children and young people by providing their basic needs, this will ameliorate their physical and emotional wellbeing, reducing parental stress, thus improving their quality of life.

Eligibility

Who can we help?

- Children and young people up to and including the age of 17 who are experiencing a crisis or emergency and live in the UK.
- We can only accept one application per household within a 12 month period.

Who are we unable to help?

- Adults aged 18 and over.
- Children and young people who do not live in the UK.
- Those who are leaving care who have access to separate, specific statutory provision.
- Children and young people who do not meet the residence criteria as defined by the programme.

How we help

We can deliver or fund critical items such as appliances, furniture and clothes.

Support Package 1

Support package 1 allows you to benefit from the item/s listed below: Personalise your package by choosing a combination of items totalling £300, that your child/ren will benefit from.

Around £100 each

- Curtains (extra wide)
- Oil filled heater
- Combination microwave oven/grill
- Rug and underlay

Around £50 each

- Slow cooker
- Clothing award(one child)
- Air fryer
- Health grill
- Steamer (electric)

Around £20 each

- Curtains
- Clothes airer
- Toaster (two slice)
- Kettle
- Toastie/sandwich maker
- Single duvet

Around £10 each

- Thick blanket
- Single duvet cover
